

Lesson Plan

Countries/Nationalities

Level: Primary A1.a

Time: about 30 minutes

Aims: *asking and answering questions, guessing, present simple, countries, cities and nationalities.*

Resources: *Simple Speaking Activities by J.Hadfield and C.Hadfield, OUP*

Procedure:

Warm up: *Revise the names of countries, cities and nationalities*

Lead in: *the teacher gives instructions for two activities*

- *Teacher draws a symbol of a country bit by bit while Ss ask questions - Are you Spanish/American...? Ss ask until the teacher answers- Yes I am.*
- *The teacher asks -Where is London? Ss must answer- It's in England.*

Main activity:

I *Ss are divided into two teams. Each team gets a pile of pictures representing certain nationalities. They come to the board and copy the object from his/her picture while others in the group must guess the nationality by asking questions. The winner is the team which guesses all the nationalities from the pictures in their pile.*

II *On small piece of paper each student should write the name of a city or certain food. All papers are put into one pile and mixed. Ss are divided into groups of three. One student takes one paper and asks the question-Where is Paris/London...? or Which country is spaghetti/hotdog from? and the other two Ss from his/her group must answer- It's in... or It's from... The student who answers first gets the card. The winner is the student with the most cards within the group.*
