"Serbian Association of Applied Art Artists and Designers (ULUPUDS)" awarded Olivera Batajic, the "Rec" magazine designer, for its layout design. However, Batajic has rejected the award saying that "the commission for this prize firstly announced the art group "Skart" had won the award for the same layout, then they phoned me asking if I was the current designer, which was kind of offensive to me".

After they were told that she would not accept the prize, "they made a decision not to give the award at all", said Olivera Batajic.

Dejan Ilic, the editor-in-chief of the "Samizdat B92", the "Rec" publisher, thinks that ULUPUDS jury had no idea who the magazine layout designer was, but that they recognized the "quality", which is much important for the publisher. "We have sold a lot of books at the Belgrade Book Fair, and it is obvious that the editorial concept and visualisation of our editions do interest people," said Ilic.

ROBBERS ARRESTED

Serbian Minister of Internal Affairs Dusan Mihajlovic announced that two persons had been arrested under suspicion of stealing 3.9 Million DM from the official vehicle of Clearing and Payment House in Pozarevac.

The Police Minister did not want to say the names of temporarily arrested persons, but he emphasized that a bigger sum of foreign currency had been found. He also said that the police were searching for a large number of other suspects in the robbery which was committed on 4 October.

Minister Mihajlovic refused to say the names of arrested persons because of an investigation which is under way and he asked the journalists to be a little patient untill the end of chase after other members of the group.

People in Pozarevac say that a half of the robbed sum was found in a barrel buried in one of the city yards.

22 TERRORISTS KILLED IN AMERICAN AIR FORCE BOMBING

Military group "Harkatul Mudzahedin", situated in Pakistan, confirmed that 22 of its members had been killed in Kabul, when the bomb hit the house in which they happened to be during the American airstrike.

This is the highest number of killed members of any organization connected with Osama Bin Laden since the begining of the American airstrikes.

USA recently put the "Harkatul Mudzahedin" on the list of groups which are involved in terrorists activities.

During the latest airstrikes, American aircraft were intensively bombing the region of Kabul. One eyewitness said that few bombs or tomahawks had exploded near the front line, wich is in the arms of the Talibans in that region.

THE ONE AND ONLY SLOBODAN MILOSEVIC

We all know who Slobodan Milosevic was and who he is now. However, the journalists always like to emphasise where he is at the moment and where he will be for a long time. The "great emperor" now "rules" in his cell in the prison with the most resounding name – Scheveningen.

From time to time, when he gets an opportunity to say a few words during pretrials, he tries to turn the tables on the Criminal Tribunal with his speeches and attitude.

He continued showing himself as a defiant and unrepentant man, during his last pre-trial appearance before the Hague Tribunal, just as he was at the time of his rule in Yugoslavia and Serbia.

Dressed in a dark suit, blue shirt and tie in Serbian national colours, he was giving us an idiosyncratic impression, but it seemed that such a kind of clothes had to hide a man who is at a deadlock and helpless.

We are used to his contempt for the Tribunal, diatribes as well, but his new reactions like shouting, jabbing his fingers and angry denunciations are just another evidence that he feigned indifference and aloofness.

Instead of an indifferent man as Milosevic initially was, we have a live bomb now. But when you hear the word "bomb" you expect an explosion. And the "explosion" is the right word to describe Milosevic's behavior during his last appearance before the Tribunal. But Senior Judge Richard May knew how to rule the coartroom. His orders in cut-glass British accent and switching off the microphones handled every situation.

In the begining there had been an indiferent man, who had sipped water, perused the public gallery, looked at his watch and who had always refused to read the charges against him. At the last pre-trial, however, we had an angry incriminator who desperately tried to cope with the Tribunal.

A lot of people continue to believe that Slobodan Milosevic is still a star performer, even though he is in prison; unfortunately, he is one of those, too!

LOSER COULD BECOME WINNER!?!
